Fiction candidates may send short stories or chapters; nonfiction candidates may send short pieces or chapters of longer works. Please double space prose and single space poetry (one poem per page.) 2. A one-page letter introducing you and your writing: topics, themes, strengths and weaknesses, publications, writing conferences attended, or anything else you feel will help introduce you and your writing.
